Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Plan was submitted to Harborough District Council (HDC) for Regulation 16 Consultation on 3rd July 2018. The Local Planning authority will undertake a validity check on the documentation and get back to the Parish Council if they require any further information. The Submission Version of the plan and supporting papers can be seen on the website at www.turlangton-pc.org.uk/neighbourhood-plan.

Once the six week Regulation 16 Consultation is completed and if HDC consider that the plan meets the relevant legislation and regulations it will then proceed to an independent examination. HDC will appoint the Examiner but needs approval from the Parish Council as Qualifying Body.

Defibrillator

We need volunteers to undertake monthly checks of the defibrillator in the phone kiosk on Main Street.

The checks are very simple and the Parish Council is aiming to have a group of volunteers so that you would not need to complete a check every month. If you are interested to find out more please contact the Clerk.

Phone Kiosk

The Parish Council now owns the phone kiosk on Main Street, which houses the defibrillator.

The council is seeking ideas of additional uses for the phone kiosk. If you have an idea for a project that you would like to take forward e.g. book swap, plant swap, art display etc and happy to organise it, perhaps trial it for one month, please get in touch with the Clerk.

Any project would need to take into account the position of the defibrillator.

Tree Protection

Our village is designated as a conservation area i.e. an area of special architectural or historic interest, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance. Within conservation areas trees are given special protection.

If you wish to top, lop, or fell a tree over 75mm (3 inches) in diameter, measured at 1.5 metres above ground you must send a written application to the council six weeks prior to the works taking place so the council can either approve the application or serve a Tree Preservation Order. Certain trees are exempt such as dead, dying or dangerous trees and some fruit trees.
