## Community Speed Watch

A Community Speed Watch Exercise was carried out in Tur Langton along Shangton Road between 7<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> September 2015. Information was sent to the police on 210 vehicles. The highest speed recorded was 51 mph.

## Neighbourhood Planning

### **Want to know more about the countryside around Tur Langton? Want to help protect it?**

Through the Neighbourhood Plan, the Parish Council is starting to consider the important green spaces around the village that can be protected from inappropriate development for future generations. This is starting with an event at the Village Hall on Tuesday, 5 January where John Martin, a geologist working with Neighbourhood Planning Consultants *Yourlocale* will take us through all of the existing open spaces that already have some protection and begin the process of identifying further spaces that are important to local people.
