SECTION 119- HIGHWAYS ACT DIVERSION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AND BRIDLEWAYS B7 (PARTS), B15 (PARTS) AND A86 (PARTS), TUR LANGTON PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

An application has been received for the diversion of Public Footpaths and Bridleways B7 (part), B15 (part) and A86 (part), Tur Langton attached Plans Proposal A and Proposal B.

The diversion has been requested in the interest of the applicant to create an easier route for walkers.

I have consulted with the Director of Environment and Transport who has stated that should the proposal be approved; the alternative footpaths and bridleways will be subject to the following conditions: -

- 1. The new footpath should have a width of 2 metres.
- 2. The new bridleway should have a width of 4 metres.
- 3. A new handgate constructed to L.C.C. design guide standards should be installed at point "D" on proposal Plan A, immediately to the north of the existing field gate.
- 4. Erections of new waymark posts constructed to L.C.C. design standardslocations to be agreed.

I should be pleased if you would let me have your Council's observations on this proposal by 9th March 2020. If I do not hear from you by this date I will assume that you have no observations to make.
