Harborough so far

By the end of our first contract we had installed fibre broadband to 65,000 properties across Leicestershire. In **Harborough** we have installed **70** cabinets, serving around **15,400** properties.

As a result we've managed to increase high speed broadband coverage in the district from **56% in 2013 to over 89% in 2016**.

In our second contract, that has already started, coverage in Harborough will increase further still; to 93%. Around 1,880 additional properties are due to gain access from 40 new fibre cabinets of which seven are already live.

In 2017 we will also be rolling out Fibre to the Premise (FTTP) technology to seven areas in Harborough, bringing superfast broadband to another 140 homes and businesses.

Remember, speed uplifts are not automatic, you need to upgrade to fibre to enjoy the benefits of superfast speeds.

The fibre journey

The Superfast Leicestershire programme has two delivery phases which we call our contract one and contract two rollouts. Contract one was completed at the end of March 2016, contract two will run until December 2017. Across the entire deployment we will be enabling fibre broadband access to 85,000 homes and businesses for the first time and will see superfast broadband coverage across Leicester and Leicestershire increase from 83% to 96%.

Take-up success

Take-up across Leicestershire has been much better than expected and has now reached 34%. There's still much more to do to reach our aspiration of 50%. We want to ensure people understand the difference fibre broadband can make to everyday tasks you do either for leisure or business.

In Harborough take-up is currently at 39% which is great. We know there's a lot more to come and we welcome any support you can give by spreading the word that superfast broadband has arrived in Harborough.

The final 4%

We have identified around 15,000 properties across Leicestershire that are not in any current high speed fibre broadband rollout plans; our final 4%. We are currently working on plans to reach more of these properties through a new phase of the programme.

£5.17 million has been made available for a new phase of the programme and we are currently reviewing how we can get the best coverage possible for this investment.

We'll have more details to share in the next newsletter – due spring 2017.

Better Broadband Scheme

The Satellite Voucher Scheme has had an upgrade! It now includes wireless broadband operators and has been renamed the Better Broadband Scheme.



The diagram above illustrates how wireless providers can help to get you connected to fibre broadband through the Better Broadband Scheme.

You can claim up to £350 towards the cost of installation. Eligible properties must currently have access to broadband speeds of less than 2Mbps and must not be due for upgrade as part of the Superfast Leicestershire rollout.
