- 1. Traffic safety measures shall conform to Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual published by HM Stationery Office or any amendment thereof for time being in force.
- 2. The following minimum additional measures to Chapter 8 are to be adopted by the Parish Council with regard to signing and road conditions:

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- 3. The Parish Council shall provide, erect and maintain on completion all necessary signs, cones etc. as required by Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual. No additional payment shall be made for this work which shall be carried out.
- 4. Every representative of the Parish Council (including sub-contractors) whilst engaged on the provision of the Service shall be provided with by their employer, and wear high visibility clothing and all vehicles shall be fitted with a minimum of one flashing amber lamp, visible from both front and rear of the vehicle and shall have signs boards reading "HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE" to diag. 7404 fixed at the rear.



5. The Parish Council shall ensure that any vehicles and machinery engaged in connection with the provision of the Service do not obstruct the visibility of other vehicle drivers and/or pedestrians.
