To be eligible you must be:

- 18 years old or over
- Either a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of the European Union

Additionally you must meet at least one of qualifying conditions below:

- Registered as a local government elector for the Tur Langton Parish from the day of co-option
- Occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in Tur Langton Parish during the whole of the 12 months before the day of co-option
- Main or only place of work during the 12 months prior to the day of co-option has been in Tur Langton Parish
- Lived in Tur Langton Parish or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 months before the day of co-option

If you are interested please send a short email or letter explaining why you should be considered for the vacancy and highlighting the skills and experience you can bring to the role, along with confirmation you meet the criteria on the Eligibility Checklist above.
